Para 3	<u>Eligibility at SP level:</u> Officers with a minimum of 5 years' service will, however, be eligible for induction in R&AW, IB, NIA and CBI.	<u>Eligibility at SP level:</u> Officers with a minimum of 5 years' service will, however, be eligible for induction in R&AW, IB, NIA, CBI and NCB.
