Annexure to Q/PA-II/578/39/2017 dated July 28/2017Mandatory Qualification:

- (i). The officer must be a serving member of the Indian Police Service of the rank of Secretary to the Government of India.
- (ii). The officer should have 'Outstanding' service record.
- (iii). The officer should not be over 40 years as on the date of circulation of the post.
- (iv). The officer must have completed at least 9 years in the Indian Police Service with relevant command experience, law enforcement experience and strategic and operational police management experience.
- (v). The officer must have at least 2 years of cumulative field command experience as SSP/SP of District Police or as DCP in Commissionerates.
- (vi). The officer must be fluent in English and possess exceptional communication and presentation skills-both written and oral and should have working knowledge of computers.
- (vii). The officer should not have been nominated for foreign posting or should not be on training or foreign assignment currently.
- (viii). The officer must not have been debarred from Foreign Deputation.
- (ix). The officer must not be on study leave or long leave
- (x). The officer must be clear from vigilance angle.

Desirable Qualifications:

- (i). Knowledge of matters relating to trafficking, violence against women, prison reforms.
- (ii). Knowledge about Police and Law enforcement aspects of the UN's work especially UN Peacekeeping.
- (iii). Knowledge about the working of the UN and India's engagement with the UN.
- (iv). Knowledge of French or any other UN language.
