
Sir,

I am directed to refer to Government of Gujarat letter no. IPS/102019/627188/B dated 27-01-2020 on the subject cited and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Gujarat Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2019 was 63, whereas 43 officers were in position as on the due date. Out of 20 vacancies, 08 vacancies are available for the Select List - 2019 due to superannuation / Voluntary retirement of 08 promotee IPS Officers in the year 2019 and remaining 12 vacancies were determined for year 2018 but no officer was recommended by the Selection Committee based on assessment. Therefore, these 12 vacancies for year 2018 are being carried forwarded to 2019.

2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with Regulation 5(1) of IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, 20 vacancies are determined for the Select List of the year 2019 for appointment by promotion of Gujarat Police Service officers to the Gujarat Cadre of Indian Police Service.

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Promotion Regulations.
