If there is any direct recruit IPS officer who has not so far undergone the mandatory Foundation Course and his name is not included in the Annexure- A, the same may be intimated to this Ministry immediately through email ID sopt@mha.gov.in so as to enable us to forward his/ her name to DoP&T for attending Special Foundation Course.

- 6. As per the Indian Police Service (Probation) Rules, 1954, if a probationers fails to obey any order which he/she may receive from the Central Government or from any other competent authority, or if in the opinion of the Central Government, he has willfully neglected his probationary studies or is guilty of conduct unbecoming of a member of the Service, he/ she may be treated under Rule- 11 (3) and 12 (c) & (d) of the IPS (Probation) Rules. 1954. In this regard, it is intimated that the officer, who do not attend the Foundation Course after his name is nominated for the Course, disciplinary action may be initiated under Rule- 11 (3) and 12 (c) & (d) of the Indian Police Service (Probation) Rules, 1954.
- 7. In view of above, State Governments are requested to get prepared for reliving the 95 backlog IPS officers of their respective States as per Annexure A upto 2019 batch for the Special Foundation Course 2022, duly instructing them to register online and confirm their participation at the earliest.
