Consequent upon appointment of 04 officers of Madhya Pradesh Police Service to the Indian Police Service of Madhya Pradesh cadre, on the basis of inclusion of their names for Select List 2024 vide MHA's Notification No. I-14011/12/2025-IPS-I(I) dated 24.12.2025 and on receipt of the proposal from Government of Madhya Pradesh, vide their letter No. एफ1/1/3/0062/2025-B-2-02(HOM) dated 17.02.2026, the seniority/year of allotment of the officer is computed under Rule 3 (3) (ii) of the IPS (Regulation of Seniority), Rules 1988, as amended from time to time and other relevant rules. No. 4** shall be placed in Civil List below **Ms Hitika Vasal (IPS: 2017)**, the junior most direct recruit IPS officer of 2017 batch of the Madhya Pradesh Cadre and above **Shri Mrigakhi Deka (IPS: 2018)**, the senior most direct recruit IPS officer of 2018 batch of Madhya Pradesh Cadre.
