Sir,

I am directed to refer UTS-I Desk's O.M. No. 14016/24/2014-UTS-I dated 07.01.2015 on the subject cited and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Arunachal Pradesh segment of Jt. AGMU Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2015 was 16, whereas 15 officers were in position on the due date. The one vacancy that is available is earmarked for the Select List of the year 2013. Therefore, nil vacancy has come into effect for preparation of Select List of the year 2014.


2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in the IPS (Recruitment) Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, it has been decided that appointment by promotion of State Police Service officers of Arunachal Pradesh to the Arunachal Pradesh Segment of Joint AGMU Cadre of Indian Police Service may be made by preparing the year-wise Select Lists of the years **2013 and 2014** upto **1 and nil vacancies** respectively in all.
