Subject:- Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of Goa Segment of Joint AGMUT Cadre of Indian Police Service for Select List of the year 2025.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to UT Division's OM No.14016/02/2026.UTS-I dated 07.04.2026 on the subject cited above and to say that 01 vacancy was determined for preparation of Select List of the year 2024. However, UT Division vide OM dated 10.09.2025 informed that no eligible officers were available in the feeder grade for consideration for promotion to IPS against the said vacancy. Accordingly, the vacancy of Select List – 2024 is liable to be carried forward to the Select List 2025.

2. Further, 02 vacancies have arisen consequent upon the cadre review of Joint AGMUT Cadre which has been finalised on 03.01.2025. Thus, total 03 vacancies are available in the promotion quota of Goa Segment of AGMUT Cadre of IPS for preparation of the Select List of 2025.

3. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **03** vacancies are determined for the Select List of the year 2025 for appointment by promotion of Goa Segment of Joint AGMUT Cadre of Indian Police Service.

4. The UT Division and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Appointment by Promotion Regulations 1955.
