**Subject:- Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of Arunachal Pradesh Segment of Joint AGMUT Cadre of Indian Police Service for Select List of the year 2025.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to UT Division's OM No.14016/02/2026.UTS-I dated 13.05.2026 on the subject cited above and to say that the authorised strength of the promotion quota for the Arunachal Pradesh Segment of AGMUT Cadre as on 01.01.2026 is 25, against which 15 posts are filled as on 01.01.2026, leaving 10 clear vacancies. Out of these 10 vacancies, 3 vacancies have already been filled vide this Ministry's Notification dated 21.04.2026, whereby 3 officers of the State Police Service were appointed to the Indian Police Service (IPS). Consequently, only 7 vacancies remain unfilled. These 7 vacancies arose during the year 2025 and are required to be determined for the Select List of 2025.

2. Further, of the 7 vacancies that arose in the year 2025, five are attributable to the cadre review of the AGMUT Cadre notified on 03.01.2025, while the remaining two vacancies arose due to the retirement of two promotee IPS officers of Arunachal Pradesh Segment of AGMUT Cadre during the same year.

3. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **07(Seven)** vacancies are determined for the Select List of the year 2025 for appointment by promotion of Arunachal Pradesh Segment of Joint AGMUT Cadre of Indian Police Service.

4. The Commission and the UT Division are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Appointment by Promotion Regulations 1955.
