Sir,


I am directed to refer to UT Division's OM No. 14016/01/2020.UTS-1 dated 21.10.2020, on the subject cited and to say that earlier this Ministry (vide letter of even no. dt. 21.07.2020) determined **NIL** vacancy for Select List 2019 for Mizoram Segment of Joint AGMUT Cadre based on the data provided by State Govt. but now it has been informed by State Govt. that **01** vacancy was over-sighted and the same needs to be reconsidered.

2. The authorised promotion quota of Mizoram Segment of AGMUT Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2020 was 11, whereas 10 officers were in position on the due date and **01** vacancy has occurred due to retirement of Sh. Josepha Lalchhuana, IPS:2003 (retired on 28.02.2019).

3. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with Regulation 5 (1) of the IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **01** vacancy is re-determined for the **Select List of the year 2019** for appointment by promotion of Mizoram Police Service officers to the Mizoram Segment of AGMUT Cadre of Indian Police Service.

4. The UT Division and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Promotion Regulations.
