Subject: Determination of vacancies for the Select List 2025 for appointment by promotion to the Indian Police Service of UT Segment of AGMUT Cadre.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to UT Division's OM No. 14016/04/2025-UTS I dated 01.01.2026 on the subject cited above and to say that the last Select List was prepared and finalized for the years 2023 and 2024, and 10 appointments were made against 11 vacancies vide Notification No. I- 14011/02(U)/2025-IPS.I dated 06.10.2025. The name of Shri Shive Kesari Singh was included in the Select List 2023 provisionally subject to clearance in criminal proceeding pending against him. Shri Shive Kesari Singh was not appointed to the IPS during the validity period of Select List 2023 and 2024. Therefore, the unfilled vacancy of Select List 2023-2024 due to the non-appointment of Shri Shive Kesari Singh is required to be carried forward to the year 2025.

2. Further, the authorized promotion quota of the UT Segment of the AGMUT Cadre of IPS as of 01.01.2026 was 70, whereas 56 officers were in position on the due date, thus making 14 vacancies in total. Out of these 14 vacancies, 02 vacancies have arisen due to the retirement of 02 officers during the year 2025, 01 vacancy has been arisen from the unfilled vacancy of Select List 2023-2024 due to the non-appointment of Shri Shive Kesari Singh is required to be carried forward to the year 2025 and 11 vacancies have been arisen consequent upon the cadre review of the IPS of Joint AGMUT Cadre, as notified by the DoP&T on 03.01.2025.

3. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954, read with Regulation 5(1) of the IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, 14 (Fourteen) vacancies are determined for the Select List of the year 2025 for appointment by promotion of UT Police Service officers to the UT Segment of AGMUT Cadre of Indian Police Service.

4. The UT Division and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955.
