**Subject: Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of officers from Assam State Police Service to the Indian Police Service of Assam Segment of Joint Assam-Meghalaya Cadre for the Select List 2019.**


Sir,

I am directed to refer to Government of Assam's letter number HMA.5/2020/8(eCF No. 131944) dated 21-02-2020 on the subject and to say that the authorized promotion quota of **Assam Segment of Joint Assam-Meghalaya Cadre** of IPS as on as on 01.01.2019 is 42 where 35 officers are in position on the due date. Out of these 07 vacancies, 05 vacancies have occurred due to retirement/superannuation of 05 officers during year 2019, 01 vacancy is carried forward from Select List of 2018 due to non-appointment of Shri Arnab Deka and 01 vacancy is occurred due to calculation of promotion quota as 42 instead of 41.

2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) (3) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **07 (05 + 01 + 01)** vacancies are determined for the Select List 2019 for appointment by promotion of Assam segment of joint Assam-Meghalaya cadre State Police Service to Indian Police Service.

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Appointment by Promotion Regulations, 1955.
