Subject: Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of Assam Police Officers to IPS of Assam Segment of Joint Assam-Meghalaya Cadre for the Select List 2021.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Government of Assam's letter No. HMA.10/2022/18 dated 10.02.2022 on the subject and to say that the authorized promotion quota of **Assam Segment of Joint Assam-Meghalaya Cadre** of IPS as on 01.01.2022 is 42, where 27 officers are in position on the due date, which makes a total 15 vacancies. Out of 15 vacancies, 07 vacancies for the year 2019 and 02 vacancies for year 2020 has already been determined. The remaining 06 vacancies have occurred due to retirement/superannuation of 06 officers during year 2021.

2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) (3) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **06** vacancies are determined for the **Select List 2021** for appointment by promotion from State Police Service to Indian Police Service of Assam segment of joint Assam-Meghalaya cadre.

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Appointment by Promotion Regulations, 1955.
