**Subject: Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of Bihar Cadre of Indian Police Service from the Select List of the year 2021.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to State Government of Bihar letter number 1/C-01-01/2022/767 dated 31.01.2022 on the subject cited and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Bihar Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2021 was 73, whereas 67 officers were in position on the due date which makes a total of 06 vacancies. Out of these 06 vacancies, 04 vacancies are available due to superannuation of 04 officers in the year 2021 and 02 unfilled vacancies have been carried forward from the Select List 2020 as the appointment of Sh. Vishwajeet Dayal & Sh. Vijay Kumar could not be made within the validity period of Select List 2020.

2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) (b) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with Regulation 5 (1) of IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **06 vacancies** are determined for the **Select List of the year 2021** for appointment by promotion of Bihar Police Service officers to the Bihar Cadre of Indian Police Service.

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Promotion Regulations.
