**Subject:- Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of Bihar Cadre of Indian Police Service from the Select List of the year 2019.**


Sir,

I am directed to refer to State Government letter no. 1/C-01/2020/Home/619 dated 27.01.2020 and letter No.1/C-01-01/2020/Home/1494 dated 12.02.2020 on the subject cited and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Bihar Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2019 was 73, whereas 65 officers were in position on the due date. Further, the 07 vacancies are available due to superannuation of 07 officers in the year 2019 and 01 unfilled vacancy has been carried forward from the Select List – 2018 as the appointment of Sh. Vishwajeet Dayal was not made within the validity period of Select List 2018.

2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) (b) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with Regulation 5 (1) of IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **08 vacancies** are determined for the **Select List of the year 2019** for appointment by promotion of Bihar Police Service officers to the Bihar Cadre of Indian Police Service.

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Promotion Regulations.
