Sub:- Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of Chhattisgarh Cadre of Indian Police Service from the Select List of the year 2015.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Government of Chhattisgarh letter No.F-01-14/2015/II- Home/IPS dated 8th February, 2016 on the subject and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Chhattisgarh Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2016 was 31, whereas 26 officers were in position on the due date. Further 3 SPS officers have been appointed into IPS of Chhattisgarh Cadre for the Select List 2014 vide Notification No.I- 14011/10/2015-IPS-1 dated 08.02.2016. Therefore, out of the authorised strength of 31, 29 officers are in position as on day. The 2 vacancies available for promotion quota of Chhattisgarh Cadre of IPS have arisen due to superannuation of Shri N K S Thakur and Shri K K Agrawal during the year 2015.

2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) (b) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with Regulation 5 (1) of IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **2 vacancies** are determined for the **Select List of the year 2015** for appointment by promotion of Chhattisgarh Police Service officers to the Chhattisgarh Cadre of Indian Police Service.

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Promotion Regulations.
