Sir,


I am directed to refer to State Government letter No. IPS/102016/1730/B dated 26th May, 2016 & 17th June, 2016 on the subject cited and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Gujarat Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2016 was 59, whereas 57 officers were in position on the due date.

2. Out of 2 vacancies, 01 vacancy were carried forward due to non-appointment of Shri N K Amin who was included provisionally in the Select List of 2014 and 01 vacancy will be available for promotion quota of Gujarat Cadre of IPS for the Select List 2015 due to superannuation of Shri I M Desai on 31/05/2016.

3. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) (b) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with Regulation 5 (1) of IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **2 vacancies** are determined for the **Select List of the year 2015** for appointment by promotion of Gujarat Police Service officers to the Gujarat Cadre of Indian Police Service.

4. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Promotion Regulations.
