Sub;- Re-Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of Kerala Cadre of Indian Police Service from the Select List of the year- 2017.


Sir,

I am directed to refer to State Government letter No- 2106022/AIS-C3/2018/GAD dated 26th June 2019 on the subject cited and to say that this Ministry had determined the vacancies for the Select List of 2016 (13 Vacancies) & 2017 (06 Vacancies) vide this Ministry's letter dated 31/05/2017 and 19/04/2018. Out of 13 Vacancies for the Select List-2016 only 12 eligible officers were appointed. 01 vacancy are left in the Select List of 2016 and this 01 vacancy are to be carry forward to the Select List of 2017. Now, in the Select List of 2017, 06 + 01=07 vacancies are available.

2. In terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with Regulations 5 (1) of the IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, re-determine the vacancies for the Select List of 2017 from 06 to 07 for appointment by promotion of Kerala Cadre of Indian Police Service.

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955.
