Sub:- Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of officers from Kerala State Police Service to Kerala Cadre of Indian Police Service for the Select List- 2017.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Government of Kerala letter No. 2106022/Spl.C3/2017/GAD dated 06.04.2018 on the subject cited and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Kerala Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2018 was 52, whereas 33 officers were in position as on the due date. Out of 19 vacancies, 13 vacancies for the Select List-2016 has already been determined vide this Ministry's No. I.14011/15/2017-IPS-1 dated 31.05.2017. Therefore, 06 vacancies are available for the Select List- 2017 due to superannuation of 06 promottee IPS Officers in the year 2017.

2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with Regulation 5(1) of IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **06 vacancies** are determined for the **Select List of the year 2017** for appointment by promotion of Kerala Police Service officers to the Kerala Cadre of Indian Police Service.

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Promotion Regulations.
