**Subject: Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion
of Madhya Pradesh Cadre of Indian Police Service from the
Select List of the year 2021.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Government of Madhya Pradesh letter No.एफ 1-2/2022/ब-2/दो dated 23.08.2022 on the subject cited above and to say that the authorized promotion quota in Madhya Pradesh Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2022 was 92, whereas 82 officers were in position on the due date. State Government has intimated that 10 vacancies have been arisen in the Madhya Pradesh cadre for the Select List 2021 due to retirement.

2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **10** vacancies are determined for the Select List of the year 2021 for appointment by promotion of Madhya Pradesh Cadre of Indian Police Service.

3. The State Govt. of Madhya Pradesh and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Appointment by Promotion Regulations 1955.
