

I am directed to refer to State Government's letter No. 3906/2516/2015/B-2/2 dated 30.11.2015 on the subject cited and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Madhya Pradesh Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2016 was 92, whereas 77 officers were in position on the due date. Therefore, 15 (fifteen) vacancies are available for the Select List of the year 2015, out of which 4 vacancies have arisen due to enhancement in the promotion quota from 88 to 92 and 11 vacancies have arisen due to retirement on superannuation of 11 promotee IPS officers of Madhya Pradesh Cadre during the year 2015.

2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in the IPS (Recruitment) Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, it has been decided that appointment by promotion of State Police Service officers of Madhya Pradesh to the Madhya Pradesh Cadre of Indian Police Service may be made by preparing the Select List of the year **2015** upto **15 vacancies** in all.
