Sub:- Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of officers from State Police Service to the Madhya Pradesh Cadre of Indian Police Service.

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Madhya Pradesh Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2017 was 92, whereas 82 officers were in position on the due date. Therefore, 10 vacancies have come into effect for preparation of Select List of the year 2016 for appointment by promotion of State Police Service to Madhya Pradesh cadre of Indian Police Service.

Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) (3) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, 10 vacancies are determined for the Select List of the year 2016 for appointment by promotion of Madhya Pradesh State Police Service to Madhya Pradesh Cadre of Indian Police Service.
