Sir,


I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to say that the authorized promotion quota in Madhya Pradesh Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2019 was 92, whereas 77 officers were in position on the due date.

2. Out of 15 vacancies, 08 vacancies have already been determined for the Select List- 2018 vide MHA's letter no. I.14011/03/2019-IPS-I dated 09-01-2019. The remaining 07 vacancies are available on retirement of 07 officers during the year 2019 and 01 additional vacancy has arisen during 2019 due to demise of 01 officer namely Shri Avinash Singh. Therefore, total 08 vacancies have come into effect for preparation of Select List of the year 2019.



Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, 08 vacancies are determined for the Select List of the year 2019 for appointment by promotion of Madhya Pradesh Cadre of Indian Police Service.
