Sub: Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of officers from Maharashtra State Police Service to Maharashtra Cadre of Indian Police Service for the Select List 2025.

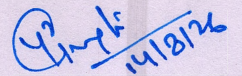
I am directed to refer to the State Government of Maharashtra's letter dated 12.03.2026 on the subject cited above and to say that the last Select List was prepared and finalized for the year 2023 and 03 appointments were made for the year 2023 vide Notification no. I-14011/13/2024-IPS-1 (I) dated 23.01.2025

2. The authorized promotion quota of Maharashtra Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2026 was 100, against which 83 officers were in position, leaving 17 vacancies. Out of these 17 vacancies, 13 vacancies have already been determined for **Select List 2024**. Further, during the year 2025, 04 vacancies have arisen due to superannuation of 03 officers and death of 01 officer. Hence, the number of vacancies available in the promotion quota of Maharashtra cadre for the Select List 2025 is 04.

3. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 9 of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **04 (four)** vacancies are determined for the Select List 2025 for appointment by promotion of officers from Maharashtra State Police Service to Maharashtra Cadre of Indian Police Service.

4. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955.
