Subject: Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of officers from State Police Service to the Maharashtra Cadre of Indian Police Service for the Select List - 2024.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the State Government's letter number IPS-2024/C.R.-186/POL-1 dated 20.02.2025 on the subject cited above and to say that that the last Select List was prepared and finalized for the year 2023 and 03 appointments were made for the year 2023 vide Notification no. I-14011/13/2024-IPS-I (I) dated 23.01.2025.

2. The authorised promotion quota of the Maharashtra Cadre of IPS as of 01.01.2025 was 100. The State Government has intimated that 09 promote officers of Maharashtra cadre have retired on superannuation in the year 2024 and 04 vacancies have occurred due to enhancement of promotion quota in cadre review, which was notified on 31.07.2024. Hence, the number of vacancies available in the promotion quota of Maharashtra cadre for the Select List 2024 is 13.

3. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954, read with the IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **13 vacancies** are determined for **Select List 2024** for appointment by promotion of Maharashtra State Police Service to Maharashtra Cadre of Indian Police Service.

4. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955.
