**Sub:- Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of Maharashtra Cadre of Indian Police Service from the Select List of the year 2015.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Government of Maharashtra letter No. IPS 0416/C.R.58/POL-1 dated 4<sup>th</sup> March, 2016 on the subject and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Maharashtra Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2016 was 91, whereas 86 officers were in position on the due date. Therefore, out of the authorised strength of 91, 86 officers are in position as on day. The 5 vacancies are available for promotion quota of Maharashtra Cadre of IPS for induction into IPS for the year 2015.

2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) (b) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with Regulation 5 (1) of IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **5 vacancies** are determined for the **Select List of the year 2015** for appointment by promotion of Maharashtra Police Service officers to the Maharashtra Cadre of Indian Police Service.

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Promotion Regulations.
