Sub:- Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of Manipur State Police Service to Manipur Cadre of Indian Police Service for the Select List- 2018.


Sir,

I am directed to refer to State Government letter No. 3/1/2019-IPS/DP dated 04.03.2019, on the subject cited and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Manipur Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2019 is 27 and in position strength is 17. Therefore, as on 01.01.2019 there are 10 vacancies. Whereas 05 vacancies for Select List of 2016 and 01 vacancy for the Select List of 2017 have been already determined vide this Ministry's letter dated 06.06.2017 and 23.02.2018. The 04 vacancies for the Select List 2018 have arisen due to retirement of 04 officers in the year 2018.

2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with Regulation 5 (1) of IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **04 vacancies are determined for the Select List of the year 2018** for appointment by promotion of Manipur Police Service officers to the Manipur Cadre of Indian Police Service.

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955.
