Sub: Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of State Police Service officers of Manipur to the Manipur Cadre of Indian Police Service from the Select List of 2015.

I am directed to refer to State Government's letter no. 3/5/2015-IPS/DP dated 07.01.2016 on the subject and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Manipur Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2016 was 27 whereas 25 promotee IPS officers were in position on the due date. Therefore, two vacancies are available for the year 2015 which have arisen due to retirement on superannuation of two promotee officers during the year 2015.

In terms of the provisions contained in IPS (Recruitment) Rules, 1954 read with IPS 2. (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, 2 (two) vacancies are determined for the Select List of the year 2015 for appointment by promotion of officers from Manipur Police Service to the Manipur Cadre of Indian Police Service.
