Sir,


I am directed to refer to State Govt. of Nagaland's letter no. POL/ESTT-1/1/2020 dated 15-01-2020 and to say that the authorized promotion quota in **Nagaland Cadre** of IPS as on 01.01.2019 was 23, whereas 19 officers were in position on the due date.

2. For year 2018, 01 vacancy has already been determined vide this Ministry's letter no. I-14011/05/2019-IPS-I dated 30-01-2019 (Copy enclosed). Therefore, 03 vacancies [23 - (19 + 01)] have arisen due to retirement of 03 officers during the year 2019 for preparation of Select List 2019 for appointment by promotion of State Police Officers of **Nagaland** to Indian Police Service of **Nagaland** Cadre.

3. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, 03 vacancies are determined for the Select List of the year 2019 for appointment by promotion of State Police Officers of **Nagaland** to Indian Police Service of **Nagaland** Cadre.

4. The State Govt. and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Appointment by Promotion Regulations 1955.
