I am directed to refer to State Govt. of Nagaland's letter No. POL/ESTT-1/1/2022/55 dated 29.01.2024 and to say that 04 appointments were made from Select List for the year 2022 vide Notification dated 13.10.2023 against 04 vacancies.

- 2. The authorized promotion quota of Nagaland Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2024 was 24, whereas 19 officers were in position on the due date, which makes a total of 05 vacancies. Out of these 05 vacancies, 01 vacancy has occurred due to enhancement of promotion quota during cadre review 2023 and 04 vacancies have been arisen due to retirement of 04 officers during the year 2023.
- 3. State Govt. has mentioned that there is no dispute in the Seniority List of empanelled SPS Officers of Nagaland.
- 4. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **05 vacancies** are determined for the Select List of the year **2023** for appointment by promotion of State Police Officers of Nagaland to Indian Police Service of Nagaland Cadre.
- 5. The State Govt. and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Appointment by Promotion Regulations 1955.
