Sir,

I am directed to refer to State Government's letter No. POL/ESTT/04/2015 dated 6<sup>th</sup> February, 2016 on the subject cited and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Nagaland Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2016 was 21, whereas 20 officers are in position on the due date. 3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Promotion Regulations.

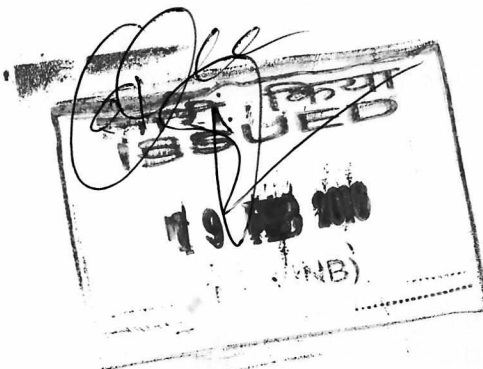
