Subject: Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of officers from Punjab State Police Service to Punjab Cadre of Indian Police Service for the Select List - 2022.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Government of Punjab letter No. 1/04/2021-4HI/413 dated 22.02.2023 on the subject and to say that the last Select List was prepared and finalized for the years 2010-2018 where 28 appointments were made against 38 vacancies. Further, this Ministry has already determined the vacancies of the Select list 2019, 2020 and 2021 as 12, 01 and 05 respectively vide letter No.14011/22/2022-IPS I(E) dated 11.10.2022.

2. The authorized promotion quota of Punjab Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2023 is 52 whereas 27 officers were in position on the due date, thus making 25 vacancies in total. Out of these 25 vacancies, 12, 01 and 05 vacancies have already been determined for the Select List 2019, 2020 and 2021 and 07 vacancies have been arisen due to retirement of 07 officers during the year 2022.

3. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **07** vacancies are determined for the **Select List 2022** for appointment by promotion of Punjab Cadre of Indian Police Service.

4. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Appointment by Promotion Regulations, 1955.
