Sub: Appointment by promotion of officers from Punjab Police Service to the Punjab Cadre of Indian Police Service during the year 2013.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to State Government's letter no. 1/22/2012-3H(I)/198 dated 16.01.2013 on the subject cited above and to say that the last Select List prepared and finalized for Punjab Cadre of IPS for appointment by promotion was that of the year 2009 which was notified by this Ministry on 10.12.2012. Further, 10 and 2 vacancies were earmarked for the year-wise Select Lists of the years 2010 and 2011 respectively. However, now one vacancy from the Select List of 2001 is to be carried forward to the Select List of 2010 due to non-appointment of an officer included provisionally in the Select List of 2001, as the validity period of the said Select List has expired. As such, 11 vacancies will be available for the Select List of 2010.

2. The authorized promotion quota of Punjab Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2013 was 52 whereas, 37 promotee IPS officers are in position on the due date. Out of the 15 vacancies thus available 11 and 2 vacancies are earmarked for the Select Lists of the years 2010 and 2011 respectively. Therefore, 2 vacancies have arisen in the year 2012

due to retirement on superannuation of two promotee IPS officers.

3. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in the IPS (Recruitment) Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, it has been decided that during the year 2013, appointment to Indian Police Service by promotion from Punjab Police Service may be made by preparing year-wise Select Lists of the years **2010, 2011 and 2012** upto **11, 2 & 2 vacancies** in all.

4. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Promotion Regulations.
