Sub: Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of officers from State Police Service of Rajasthan to the Rajasthan Cadre of Indian Police Service from the Select List of the year 2015.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to State Government's letter no. F.6(5)Pers/A-I/2015 dated 01.01.2016 on the subject and to say that the effective promotion quota of Rajasthan Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2016 was 65 whereas 59 officers were in position on the due date. Out of the 6 vacancies available, 3 vacancies have arisen due to enhancement in the promotion quota from 62 to 65 due to Cadre Review, 2015. Though 4 promotee IPS officers have retired during the year 2015, Shri Prem Prakash Tak who was dislodged in the Review Select List of 2008 is still incumbent under order dated 09.02.2015 of the Hon'ble CAT, Jodhpur Bench in O.A. No. 290/00013/2015. Hence, six vacancies are available in the promotion quota of Rajasthan cadre of IPS.



- 2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in the IPS (Recruitment) Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, appointment by promotion of State Police Service officers of Rajasthan to the Rajasthan Cadre of Indian Police Service may be made by preparing Select List of the year 2015 upto 6 vacancies in all.
- 3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Promotion Regulations.
