

I am directed to refer to Government of Tamil Nadu letter No. HSC2/870-3/2015 dated 08.02.2016 on the subject cited and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Tamil Nadu Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2016 was 80, whereas 72 officers were in position on the due date. Out of these 8 vacancies, 1 vacancy has been carried forwarded due to non-appointment of Shri M Manohar who was included provisionally in the Select List of 2013, 3 vacancies have arisen due to superannuation of 3 promottee IPS Officers in the year 2014 and 4 vacancies have arisen due to superannuation of 4 promottee IPS officers in 2015.

2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) (b) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with Regulation 5(1) of IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, 4 vacancies are determined for the Select List of the year 2014 and 4 vacancies are determined for the Select List of the year 2015 for appointment by promotion of Tamil Nadu Police Service officers to the Tamil Nadu Cadre of Indian Police Service.

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Promotion Regulations.
