**Subject:- Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of Tamil Nadu Cadre of Indian Police Service from the Select List of the year 2019.**


Sir,

I am directed to refer to Government of Tamil Nadu letter no. HSC2/1077-4/2019 dated 14-02-2020 on the subject cited above and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Tamil Nadu Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2019 was 84, whereas 70 officers were in position on the due date. Out of these 14 vacancies, 11 vacancies for the Select List – 2018 were determined vide this Ministry's letter No. I.14011/11/2019-IPS-1 dated 10-05-2019. Further, remaining 03 vacancies has occurred in the year 2019 due to retirement of 03 officers.

2. Further, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with Regulation 5(1) of IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **03 vacancies** are determined for the **Select List of the year 2019** for appointment by promotion of Tamil Nadu Police Service officers to the Tamil Nadu Cadre of Indian Police Service.

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Promotion Regulations.
