Subject: Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of SPS Officers of Tamil Nadu to Indian Police Service for the Select List of the year 2023.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Government of Tamil Nadu letter no. HSC2/267-4/2023 dated 27.03.2024 on the subject cited above and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Tamil Nadu Cadre of IPS as of 01.01.2024 was 84, whereas 51 officers were in position on the due date, which makes a total of 33 vacancies. Out of these 33 vacancies, 28 have already been determined for the Select List 2018 (11), 2019 (03), 2020 (05), 2021 (06), and 2022 (03), whereas the remaining 05 vacancies have occurred due to the retirement of 05 SPS officers during the year 2023.

2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with Regulation 5(1) of IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **05 vacancies** are determined for the **Select List of the year 2023** for appointment by promotion of Tamil Nadu Police Service officers to the Tamil Nadu Cadre of Indian Police Service.

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Promotion Regulations.
