Subject:- Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of SPS Officers of Tamil Nadu to Indian Police Service for the Select List of the year 2022.


Sir,

I am directed to refer to Government of Tamil Nadu letter no. HSC2/e 6123-7/2022 dated 23.05.2023 on the subject cited above and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Tamil Nadu Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2023 was 84, whereas 56 officers were in position on the due date which makes a total of 28 vacancies. Out of these 28 vacancies, 11 vacancies for year 2018, 03 vacancies for year 2019, 05 vacancies for year 2020 and 06 vacancies for year 2021 have already been determined. However, meeting of the Selection Committee has not been held to finalize these vacancies. The remaining 03 vacancies have occurred during the year 2022 due to retirement of 03 State Police Officers.

2. Hence, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with Regulation 5(1) of IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **03 vacancies** are determined for the **Select List of the year 2022** for appointment by promotion of Tamil Nadu Police Service officers to the Tamil Nadu Cadre of Indian Police Service.

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Promotion Regulations.
