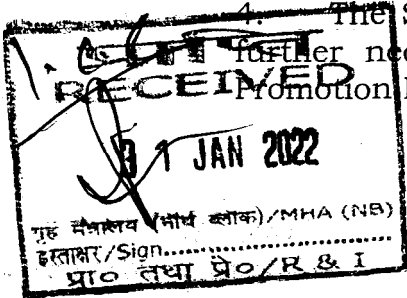
Sir,

I am directed to refer to Government of Tripura letter number F.2(1)-GA(P&T)/2022 dated 10.01.2022 on the subject cited above and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Tripura Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2021 was 21, whereas 13 officers are in position on due date, which makes a total of 08 vacancies. Out of these 08 vacancies, MHA vide letter number I-14011/09/2018-IPS.I(E) dated 21.02.2018 has determined 03 vacancies for the year 2017 and vide letter number 14011/09/2019-IPS.I(E) dated 11.08.2021 has determined 01 vacancy for the year 2018, 01 vacancy for the year 2019 and 03 vacancies for the year 2020.

2. 01 vacancy has occurred during the year 2021 due to retirement of Shri Rajesh Sharma, IPS (TR:2000).

3. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) (3) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **01** vacancy is determined for the Select List of the year **2021** for appointment by promotion of Tripura State Police Service to Tripura Cadre of Indian Police Service.

4. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Appointment by Promotion Regulations 1955.
