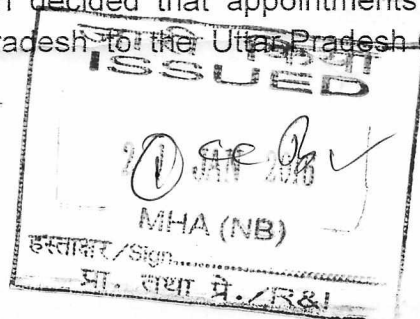
**Sub: Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of officers from Uttar Pradesh Police Service to the Uttar Pradesh Cadre of Indian Police Service from the Select List of the year 2015.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Government of Uttar Pradesh letter No. 35DG/SPS-2-16-538(1)/2016 dated 15.01.2016 on the subject and to say that out of the authorized promotion quota of 157, 140 officers were in position as on 01.01.2016 in the Uttar Pradesh. Out of 17 vacancies, one vacancy has been reserved in compliance of interim orders in O.A. No. 153/2015 filed by Dr. Badri Narayan Tiwari before the Hon'ble CAT Allahabad Bench, 15 vacancies have arisen due to retirement/death of promottee IPS officers during the year 2015 and one vacancy is carried forward from the Select List of 2014 due to non-appointment of Shri Jai Prakash Singh.

2. In view of the above, in terms of the provisions contained in the IPS (Recruitment) Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, it has been decided that appointments by promotion of State Police Service officers of Uttar Pradesh to the Uttar Pradesh Cadre of Indian Police Service may be

made by preparing the Select List of the year 2015 upto 16 vacancies in all. One vacancy shall be kept reserved separately for Dr. Badri Narayan Tiwari as per the orders dated 11.03.2015 and 27.04.2015 of the Hon'ble CAT, Allahabad Bench in O.A. No. 153/2015.

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Promotion Regulations.
