
Sir,

I am directed to refer to Government of Uttar Pradesh letter number 132DG/6PS-2-20-538(1)/2020 dated 26-02-2020 on the subject and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Uttar Pradesh Cadre of IPS as on as on 01.01.2019 is 157 where 137 officers are in position on the due date. Out of these 20 vacancies, 19 vacancies have occurred due to retirement/superannuation of 19 officers during year 2019 and 01 unfilled vacancy is being carried forward from the Select List-2018.

2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) (3) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, 20 (19 + 1 carry forwarded) vacancies are determined for the Select List-2019 for appointment by promotion of Uttar Pradesh State Police Service to Uttar Pradesh Cadre of Indian Police Service.

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Appointment by Promotion Regulations, 1955.
