
Sir,

I am directed to refer to Government of Uttar Pradesh letter number 20डीजी/छ:पु0से0-2-23-538(1)/2023 dated 13.01.2023 on the subject and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Uttar Pradesh Cadre of IPS as on as on 01.01.2023 is 164 where 136 officers are in position on the due date which makes a total of 28 vacancies. Out of these 28 vacancies, 26 vacancies have occurred due to retirement/death/Cadre Review during year 2022 and 02 unfilled vacancies is being carried forward from the Select List-2021.

2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **28** (26 + 02 carry forwarded) vacancies are determined for the **Select List-2022** for appointment by promotion of Uttar Pradesh State Police Service to Uttar Pradesh Cadre of Indian Police Service.

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Appointment by Promotion Regulations, 1955.
