Sir,

I am directed to refer to State Government letter No. 927/XX(1)-2019-2(1)/2001 dated 27.12.2019 on the subject cited above and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Uttarakhand Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2019 was 22, whereas 19 officers were in position on the due date. Therefore, 03 vacancies have come into effect for preparation of Select List of the year 2019 for appointment by promotion of State Police Service to Uttarakhand cadre of Indian Police Service.

Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) (3) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **03 vacancies** are determined for the Select List of the **year 2019** (i.e. 03 vacancies have arisen due to superannuation of Shri Ajay Joshi on 30.06.2019, Ganesh Singh Martolia on 31-08-2019 and Roshan Lal Sharma on 30-11-2019).

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Appointment by Promotion Regulations, 1955.
