Sub:- Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of West Bengal Cadre of Indian Police Service from the Select Lists of the year 2015.


Sir,

I am directed to refer to State Government letter No. No. 1/C-01/2014 Home /688 dated 24.05.2016 on the subject cited and to say that the authorized promotion quota of West Bengal Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2016 was 105, whereas 90 officers were in position on the due date.

2. Out of 15 vacancies, 13 vacancies are available due to non-appointment in the Select List of 2013 & 2014 which have been carried forward for the Select List-2015. Further, 2 vacancies will be available for promotion quota of West Bengal Cadre of IPS for the Select List 2015 due to superannuation of Shri Dilip Bandyopadhyay and Subrata Bandopadhyay.

3. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) (b) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with Regulation 5 (1) of IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **15 vacancies** are determined for the **Select List of the year 2015** for appointment by promotion of West Bengal Police Service officers to the West Bengal Cadre of Indian Police Service.

4. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Promotion Regulations.
