
Sir,

I am directed to refer to the State Government of West Bengal's letter number 738-PS Cell/HR/O/3P-01/2020 dated 04.09.2020 on the subject cited above and to say that the authorized promotion quota of **West Bengal** Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2020 was 105, whereas 86 officers are in position on the due date. As such, as on 01.01.2020 there are 19 vacancies out of which **08** vacancies have already been determined for year 2017 & **09** for year 2018. The remaining 02 vacancies have arisen due to retirement of 02 IPS Officers during the year 2019.

2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **02 vacancies** are determined for the **Select List 2019** for appointment by promotion of Karnataka State Police Service to **West Bengal Cadre** of Indian Police Service.

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Appointment by Promotion Regulations 1955.
