Sub:- Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of officers from West Bengal State Police Service to West Bengal Cadre of Indian Police Service for the Select List- 2017.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Government of West Bengal letter No. 194-P.S Cell/HR/O/3P-02/2018 dated 02.02.2018 on the subject cited and to say that the authorized promotion quota of West Bengal Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2018 was 105, whereas 84 officers were in position as on the due date. Out of 21 vacancies, 16 vacancies for the Select List-2016 has already been determined vide this Ministry's No. I.14011/14/2017-IPS-1 dated 22.01.2018. Therefore, 05 vacancies are available for the Select List- 2017 due to superannuation of 05 promottee IPS Officers in the year 2017.

2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with Regulation 5(1) of IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **05 vacancies** are determined for the **Select List of the year 2017** for appointment by promotion of West Bengal Police Service officers to the West Bengal Cadre of Indian Police Service.

3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Promotion Regulations.
