
Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject mentioned above and to say that in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, the matter of determination of vacancies arising during the year 2016 has been examined in this department. Further in terms of the provisions contained in Regulation 5 (1) of the IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, read with the relevant provisions in the Recruitment Rules the number of post up to which recruitment may be made by Promotion to the West Bengal Cadre of IPS for the vacancies arising during the year 2016 has also been examined.

2. In terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, 6 vacancies are determined provisionally for the Select List of the year 2016 for appointment by promotion of West Bengal State Police Service to West Bengal Cadre of Indian Police Service.
