Subject:- Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of J&K Segment of Joint AGMUT Cadre of Indian Police Service for Select List of the year 2025.

Sir,

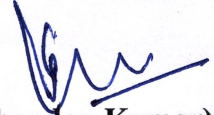
I am directed to refer to UT Division's OM No.14016/02/2026.UTS-I dated 24.04.2026 on the subject cited above and to say that the authorised strength of the promotion quota for the AGMUT Cadre (J&K Segment) as on 01.01.2026 is 47, against which 34 posts are presently filled, leaving 13 clear vacancies. Out of these, 08 vacancies have already been determined for the Select Lists of the years 2021, 2022, 2023, and 2024. The remaining 05 vacancies have arisen during the year 2025 which needs to be determined for Select List 2025.

2. Further, of the five vacancies that arose in the year 2025, three are attributable to the cadre review of the AGMUT Cadre notified on 03.01.2025, while the remaining two vacancies arose due to the retirement of two promotee IPS officers of the AGMUT Cadre (J&K Segment) during the same year.

3. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **05** vacancies are determined for the Select List of the year 2025 for appointment by promotion of J&K Segment of Joint AGMUT Cadre of Indian Police Service.

4. The Commission and the UT Division are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Appointment by Promotion Regulations 1955.
