I am directed to refer to the State Government of Karnataka's letter number e-DPAR 176 SPS 2020 dated 06.01.2021 on the subject cited and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Karnataka Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2020 was 65, whereas 33 officers are in position on the due date which makes a total of 32 vacancies to come into effect. Out of these 32 vacancies, 28 vacancies have already been determined for year 2016 (17), 2017 (03), 2018 (04) & 2019 (04).
