Sir,

I am directed to refer to the State Government of Karnataka's letter number e-DPAR 11 SPS 2019 dated 17.11.2020 on the subject cited and to say that the authorized promotion quota of **Karnataka** Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2020 was 65, whereas 37 officers are in position on the due date. As such, as on 01.01.2020 there are 28 vacancies out of which 17 vacancies have already been determined for year 2016, 03 for year 2017 & 04 for year 2018. The remaining 04 vacancies have arisen due to retirement of 03 IPS Officers & demise of 01 IPS officer during the year 2019.

- 2. Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, **04 vacancies** are determined for the **Select List 2019** for appointment by promotion of Karnataka State Police Service to **Karnataka Cadre** of Indian Police Service.
- 3. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS Appointment by Promotion Regulations 1955.
