Sir,

I am directed to refer to Government of Maharashtra letter No. IPS 0717/C.R.42/POL-1 dated 10th April, 2017 on the subject and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Maharashtra Cadre of IPS as on 01.01.2017 was 91, whereas 82 officers were in position on the due date. Therefore, 9 vacancies are available for promotion quota of Maharashtra Cadre of IPS for induction into IPS for the year 2016.
